TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES

1. Players in the 12, 14, 16 & 18 Under of the Boys and Girls who made the top four of their respective regions (Luzon/NCR and VisMin) as of March 31, 2023 are eligible to participate in the 2023 UTP National Championships – Elite Eight Playoffs.
2. Players who are next in line per region will move up in case any of the eligible players in the top four will not be able to participate.
3. If a particular age group will not be completed by a region from the top 32 ranking, UTP reserves the right to nominate a wildcard from any region. Last minute withdrawals will also be replaced by a wildcard.
4. Players who qualified in the top four of two age groups can only play in his or her main category.
5. The schedule of the playoffs is from June 1 to 4, but players are required to be at the venue by May 31.
6. Venue is at San Carlos Tennis Association (SACATA), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental.
7. UTP reserves the right to amend the tournament guidelines, format, and incentive when deemed necessary.

TRANSPORTATION

- 1.Players will be directly responsible for the cost of their transportation going to San Carlos City, Negros Occidental.
- 2.For players coming from Luzon/NCR, SACATA will provide a shuttle bus that will fetch and bring the players from and to Bacolod-Silay Aiport In the morning of May 31 and June 5, respectively.

BOARD AND LODGING

- 1.SACATA will provide a free dorm for players. Each player is allowed to bring one parent or guardian who can stay in the dorm. However, the dorm can only accommodate a maximum of 64 pax. Priority will be given to those in real need.
- 2.A designated players' hotel will also be arranged but at the expense of the player/parent. The parents will be directly responsible for booking the hotel. The name & contact number of the hotel will be communicated separately.
- 3.The average room rate of a boutique hotel is P2,500 per room while a budget hotel is P700 per room.
- 4.Food will be for the account of the player and parent except for the Fellowship Dinner on May 31 and Awarding Dinner on June 4.

TOURNAMENT INCENTIVE

1. The finalist and champion of each age-group category will earn an incentive trip in an international tournament in Southeast Asia within the year. In case any of the players are not available to participate, the trip will be given to the 3rd place player.
2. The 3rd place will be decided by a quotient system between the two losing semi-finalists.
3. UTP will sponsor and arrange the airfare, hotel, land transportation, tournament entry fee, and travel tax of the players. Each player will be given a daily allowance (USD15.00) to cover food expenses.
4. Players from Luzon/NCR will be responsible for going to the NAIA airport on the departure date of the tournament while players from VisMin will be responsible for going to Mactan International Airport.
5. Securing of passport, DSWD clearance, and transport going to the airport will be shouldered by the player.
6. Parents who wish to accompany their children will pay for own expenses and make their own arrangements.
7. Players in the round-robin will earn 100 points; semi-finalists - 150 points; finalists - 200 points; and champion - 250 points.
